DAY 1: WELCOME TO ROME, THE ETERNAL CITY

Route: Civitavecchia ▶ Bolsena/Acquapendente ▶ Castelnuovo dell'Abate

Morning

- Arrival in the morning and meeting with Red Travel staff at *Rome Fiumicino International Airport*. Transfer by Mercedes E-Class to the exclusive [Sporting Yacht Club](#) followed by a dedicated Ferrari briefing, with your Ferrari scenically displayed in front of the yachts.

Our private Tour Director, an expert Ferrari driver, will introduce our guests to the world of Ferrari; clarify the finer details of the controls, explain the differences between the various models (Ferrari F8 Tributo, Ferrari 488 Spider, Ferrari 488 Pista, Ferrari Portofino) and the engine (new 8-cylinder turbo) and most importantly, give guidance on how to handle the F1 paddle-gear shifting behind the steering wheel.

- All luggage will be transported separately.

Departure by Ferrari in direction of Bolsena lake

After a short Ferrari practice-drive a pleasant drive along the panoramic and enchanting roads of the mythical Mille Miglia, passing Tarquinia, Viterbo, Bolsena, Acquapendente, Radicofani, etc. Our Tour Director will lead the way at the wheel of his powerful car enabling our guests to discover the picturesque and breathtaking panorama offered by the valley landscape, their enjoyment enriched by the experience of pure driving pleasure on an amazing succession of rolling hills and never-ending curves!

During the whole journey, the Ferraris and the Tour Director's car will be constantly in touch by mobile radio system.

Afternoon

15:00: Departure by Ferrari towards the magnificent Val d'Orcia

- Arrival at [Castello di Velona Resort](#) and check-in.

Castello di Velona Resort, Thermal Spa & Winery is a National Monument, a renovated fortress dating back from the XI century, on the top of a hill overlooking the entire Val d'Orcia. Located in Montalcino County only 9 km away from the town center, Castello di Velona is known for its thermal OLI SPA and for producing one of the best 10 Brunello di Montalcino wine, as well as Extravirgin Olive Oil.

Dinner in Castelnuovo dell'Abate - Restaurant suggestions: **Settimo Senso**, for an elegant emotional dinner, or **Brunello**, for a Tuscan-like retreat.



Overnight at **Castello di Velona Resort, Thermal Spa & Winery 5*** (Montalcino, Siena).

DAY 2: VAL D'ORCIA

Route: Castelnuovo dell'Abate ▶ Pienza ▶ Montepulciano ▶ Montalcino ▶ Castelnuovo dell'Abate

Morning

- Meeting with the Tour Director after breakfast.

Departure by Ferrari for a tour of the magnificent Val d'Orcia

A day to revel in the spectacular panorama offered by this delightful Tuscan valley, known worldwide for its extensive vineyards.

In his car, Red Travel Tour Director leads the tour through a succession of enchanting towns and villages, whose charming appeal encapsulates the very soul of the Val d'Orcia.

- First stop is Montepulciano, archetypical Tuscan mediaeval town built at the summit of a hill as well and surrounded by walls and fortifications. The place is famous for its *Vino Nobile*, one of Italy's major red wines.
- The tour heads towards Pienza, Pope Pius'II birthplace, located high on a hillside. Meant to be the ideal Renaissance town, Pienza comprises such beauties as a white stone cathedral, Palazzo Piccolomini with its fine courtyard, Palazzo Borgia, a graceful Piazza...

Afternoon

- The next stage is Montalcino, reached by meandering through the vineyards that provide grapes for the production of the famous Brunello. You will taste this top-class red wine at the estate of Biondi Santi (subject to availability) after visiting the cellar of this masterful wine producer.

A visit to the historical centre of Montalcino with its fort and the churches of Sant'Agostino and Sant'Egidio is also a must.

- Arrival at [Castello di Velona - Resort, Thermal Spa & Winery](#) and free time to relax at the OLI SPA. The hotel host a SPA, set over an area of over 1500 m², is equipped with two outdoor Spa pools (one of them is always equipped with hydromassage), five treatment rooms, one room for couples treatment, a Turkish bath, a sauna and sensory showers. The hot spring water in the SPA flows at a temperature of 50°C and can be classed as "hyper-thermal". It is rich in mineral salts, contains bicarbonate, sulphate, calcium and magnesium, and its chemical composition is indicated for therapeutic use.



Evening



Dinner in Seggiano - Restaurant suggestion: **Silene** (1 Michelin star).

Located in a quiet spot, this is an old inn which has been renovated over the years. Elegant dining hall with nice furniture. Traditional cuisine and innovative dishes.



Overnight at **Castello di Velona - Resort, Thermal Spa & Winery** (Montalcino, Siena).

DAY 3: SIENA AND FLORENCE

Route: Castelnuovo dell'Abate ▶ Siena ▶ Florence

Morning

- Meeting with the Tour Director after breakfast and checkout.

Departure by Ferrari for Siena, driving along one of the most scenic roads featured in the original itinerary of the Mille Miglia race

Siena, an unspoiled mediaeval city, is the location of the famous Palio, a horse race around the city's shell-shaped Piazza del Campo. Siena's other historic gems from the Middle Ages include the Town Hall (Palazzo Pubblico) and the Torre dei Mangia (1340), which are similar in height to the Cathedral.

- Free time to explore Siena.



Lunch in Siena - Restaurant suggestion: **Al Mangia**, located in Piazza del Campo, Siena's main square.

Afternoon

Departure by Ferrari for Florence

Next milestones of the famous Mille Miglia: Monteriggioni, Poggibonsi, San Casciano Val di Pesa, Florence, passing through the famous Chianti region vineyards.

- Arrival in Florence and check-in at the splendid hotel **Il Salviatino**. Accommodation in deluxe room.



Il Salviatino is a luxuriously refurbished Renaissance villa set within the sloping hills of Fiesole, yet only a stone's throw away from the Florence city centre. Surrounded by a 50,000 m² (12.5 acres) private park, the hotel was built in the 14th century and for centuries was used as a cultural gathering place for artists, performers, and intellectuals. The sumptuous Spa Il Salviatino is located in the greenest corner of the villa's private park, immersed in the luxurious gardens, where relaxation in a welcoming atmosphere is the crowning touch to the select treatments performed by highly qualified personnel.
