### DAY 3: FERRARI SELF DRIVE FOLLOWING THE MILLE MIGLIA ROUTE

Route: Civitavecchia ▶ Viterbo ▶ Bolsena ▶ Castelnuovo dell'Abate

#### Morning

- Transfer by private car from your hotel to Civitavecchia's "Riva di Traiano" tourist harbour on the Roman coast.
- Welcome aperitif in the exclusive *Sporting Yacht Club* followed by a dedicated Ferrari briefing, with your Ferrari scenically displayed in front of the yachts.

Our private Tour Director, an expert Ferrari driver, will introduce our guests to the world of Ferrari; clarify the finer details of the controls, explain the differences between the various models (Ferrari 488 Spider, Ferrari Portofino) and the engines (new 8-cylinder turbo) and most importantly, give guidance on how to handle the F1 paddle-gear shifting behind the steering wheel.

- All luggage will be transported separately.

#### Departure by Ferrari for Bolsena

After a short Ferrari practice-drive a pleasant drive along the panoramic and enchanting roads of the mythical Mille Miglia, passing Tarquinia, Viterbo, Bolsena, Acquapendente, Radicofani, etc. Our Tour Director will lead the way at the wheel of his powerful Alfa Romeo Giulia, enabling our guests to discover the picturesque and breathtaking panorama offered by the valley landscape, their enjoyment enriched by the experience of pure driving pleasure on an amazing succession of rolling hills and never-ending curves!

During the whole journey, the Ferrari and the Tour Director's car will be constantly in touch by mobile radio system.

#### Departure by Ferrari for Castelnuovo dell'Abate

- Arrival at **Castello di Velona Resort** and check-in.

Castello di Velona Resort, Thermal Spa & Winery is a National Monument, a renovated fortress dating back from the XI century, on the top of a hill overlooking the entire Val d'Orcia. Located in Montalcino County only 9 km away from the town center, Castello di Velona is known for its thermal OLI SPA and for producing one of the best 10 Brunello di Montalcino wine, as well as Extravirgin Olive Oil.

Dinner in Castelnuovo dell'Abate - Restaurant suggestions: **Settimo Senso**, for an elegant emotional dinner, or **Brunello**, for a Tuscan-like retreat.



Overnight at **Castello di Velona Resort, Thermal Spa & Winery 5\*** (Montalcino, Siena).

#### **DAY 4: VAL D'ORCIA**

*Route:* Castelnuovo dell'Abate ▶ Montepulciano ▶ Pienza ▶ Montalcino ▶ Castelnuovo dell'Abate

##### **Morning**

Departure by Ferrari for a tour of the magnificent Val d'Orcia



A day to revel in the spectacular panorama offered by this delightful Tuscan valley, known worldwide for its extensive vineyards.

In his car, Red Travel Tour Director leads the tour through a succession of enchanting towns and villages, whose charming appeal encapsulates the very soul of the Val d'Orcia.

- First stop is Montepulciano, archetypical Tuscan mediaeval town built at the summit of a hill as well and surrounded by walls and fortifications. The place is famous for its *Vino Nobile*, one of Italy's major red wines.
- The tour heads towards Pienza, Pope Pius' II birthplace, located high on a hillside. Meant to be the ideal Renaissance town, Pienza comprises such beauties as a white stone cathedral, Palazzo Piccolomini with its fine courtyard, Palazzo Borgia, a graceful Piazza...



Lunch in Pienza - Restaurant suggestion: **La Terrazza del Chiostro**.

##### **Afternoon**

- The next stage is Montalcino, reached by meandering through the vineyards that provide grapes for the production of the famous Brunello. You will taste this top-class red wine at the estate of Biondi Santi (subject to availability) after visiting the cellar of this masterful wine producer.





A visit to the historical centre of Montalcino with its fort and the churches of Sant'Agostino and Sant'Egidio is also a must.

- Arrival at [Castello di Velona](#) and time at disposal.

### Evening



Dinner in Seggiano - Restaurant suggestion: **Silene** (1 Michelin star).

Located in a quiet spot, this is an old inn which has been renovated over the years. Elegant dining hall with nice furniture. Traditional cuisine and innovative dishes.

- Return to the hotel after dinner.



Overnight at **Castello di Velona Resort, Thermal Spa & Winery 5\*** (Castelnuovo dell'Abate, Siena).

## DAY 5: SIENA & FLORENCE

Route: Castelnuovo dell'Abate ▶ Siena ▶ Florence

### Morning

Departure by Ferrari for Siena, driving along one of the most scenic roads featured in the original itinerary of the Mille Miglia race

Siena, an unspoiled mediaeval city, is the location of the famous Palio, a horse race around the city's shell-shaped Piazza del Campo. Siena's other historic gems from the Middle Ages include the Town Hall (Palazzo Pubblico) and the Torre dei Mangia (1340), which are similar in height to the Cathedral.

- Free time to explore Siena.



Lunch in Siena - Restaurant suggestion: **Al Mangia**, located in Piazza del Campo, Siena's main square.

### Afternoon

Departure by Ferrari for Florence

Next milestones of the famous Mille Miglia: Monteriggioni, Poggibonsi, San Casciano Val di Pesa, Florence, passing through the famous Chianti region vineyards.

- Arrival and check-in at [Four Seasons Hotel Firenze](#). Accommodation in Junior Suite.



An enchanted city sanctuary in the midst of Florence, where an art-filled Renaissance palazzo and conventino frame a centuries-old private park. Relax amidst original frescoes and sculptured relieves, graced by sunlight and airy garden vistas. Sip cappuccino under majestic trees, lounge by the open-air pool or bask in Italian spa secrets. Wonders of the Uffizi and Duomo are a stroll away. Tuscan hill towns beckon.

- Guided tour of the historical centre by feet (upon request).

## **DAY 6: PISA AND ARGENTARIO, ON THE TUSCAN COAST**

Route: Florence ▶ Pisa ▶ Porto Ercole

### **Morning**

Early departure by Ferrari for Pisa, home of the renowned leaning tower and the Piazza dei Miracoli



Lunch in Pisa - Restaurant suggestions: **Antica Trattoria da Bruno**, **Osteria del Violino**.

### **Afternoon**

Departure by Ferrari towards Argentario, on the Tuscan coast

- Arrival and check-in at **Hotel Il Pellicano 5\***.

A magnificent retreat on the Tuscan coast, surrounded by centuries-old olive trees set in an extensive garden.

The Argentario Peninsula is plenty of many beautiful spots to see in a short time: only 7 miles separate Cala Galera from the tiny island of Giannutri, home of thousands of seagulls, and only 13 miles away is the lively island of Giglio. For those who like to cruise « off-the-beaten tracks », the waters of the preserved marine area of the island of Montecristo are certainly worth a detour. Not to be missed the gourmet restaurant of the hotel, awarded since 2005 with 1 Michelin star.

Dinner in Porto Ercole - Restaurant suggestion: **Il Pellicano** (1 Michelin star) at the hotel.



Overnight at **Il Pellicano 5\*** (Porto Ercole, Grosseto).

### Morning

- Whole day at your disposal to enjoy the Italian coast, with a dip in the sea from the private beach, a swim in the indoor pool or a relaxing walk on the Tyrrhenian coast.

On request: tour by private boat around the Argentario cape or to the nearby islands of Giglio and Giannutri.
