DAY 2: *Umbria, & southern Tuscany*

Route: Rome ▶ Orvieto ▶ Montalcino

Morning

- Meeting with your personal Tour Assistant, who will introduce you to the use of your Maserati, if you have chosen a self-driven tour, or will present the program of the forthcoming days if you prefer a chauffeured services.



Drive by Maserati from your hotel to Castiglion del Bosco

- Halt en route in Orvieto for a short visit and lunch.

Orvieto is a little beautiful town in Umbria famous for its Cathedral and its Well of St. Patrick. Orvieto, an unspoiled mediaeval city, world-renowned to be a perfect example of integration between nature and man's work, is an ancient Etruscan city (Velzna) that reached its pinnacle as a commercial centre in the VI century BC. Subsequently, it was invaded and destroyed by the Romans in 264 BC.

Re-established in the Middle Ages under the name of Urbs Vetus; today the town still has the appearance of a stronghold in tufa and basalt, chiselled with a network of narrow roads, and a labyrinth of underground passages and tunnels.

Time at disposal to visit the town and the famous well of St. Patrick.

Afternoon

- Arrival at [Castiglion del Bosco](#) and check-in at [Il Borgo](#).

Situated in the heart of Tuscany's Brunello winemaking region, Castiglion del Bosco is one of Tuscany's largest contiguous estates. It is located in the Val d'Orcia 12 kilometers northwest of Montalcino, in the Province of Siena, just 95 kilometers south of Florence and 200 kilometers north of Rome. Its vast property spans ten kilometers, comprising nearly 4,500 spectacular acres of protected nature preserve.

- Possibility of enjoying a dedicated wine tasting in the splendid winery of Castiglion del Bosco.

DAY 3: *Val D'Orcia, and Wine Tour*

Route: Montalcino ▶ Pienza ▶ Montepulciano ▶ Montalcino

Morning

- After breakfast, meeting with your private chauffeur and departure for a tour of Val d'Orcia.



Pleasant drive along the panoramic and enchanting roads of Val d'Orcia. The roads carefully selected by Red Travel ensure maximum pleasure for your eyes as you enjoy the beautiful landscape of southern Tuscany

The itinerary for today includes the visits of the most beautiful places in Val d'Orcia, as Pienza, Montepulciano and Montalcino. Whilst driving, our guests will be able to enjoy outstanding views of the famous Tuscan vineyards on either side of the road. Mediaeval villages and the beautiful natural landscape offer an overwhelming feast for the eyes.

On the way to Pienza, approaching Monticchiello, along the renowned zigzagging cypress lined road, a famous professional Tuscan photographer will be ready to shoot you and your Maserati in the incredible natural set offered by the Tuscan countryside, decorated by cypress and gentle hills.

- First stop is Pienza, Pope Pius' II birthplace, located high on a hillside. Meant to be the ideal Renaissance town, Pienza comprises such beauties as a white stone cathedral, Palazzo Piccolomini with its fine courtyard, Palazzo Borgia, a graceful Piazza...
- The tour heads towards Montepulciano, archetypical Tuscan mediaeval town built at the summit of a hill as well and surrounded by walls and fortifications. The place is famous for its *Vino Nobile*, one of Italy's major red wines.



13:00: Lunch in Montepulciano in a private garden in front of the beautiful St. Biagio Temple.



Afternoon



15:00: Departure to Montalcino

- Arrival in Montalcino, reached meandering through the vineyards that provide the grapes for the production of the famous Brunello. You will taste this top-class red wine at the estate of Biondi Santi (subject to availability) after visiting the cellar of this masterful wine producer.
- A visit of the historical centre of Montalcino with its fort and the churches of Sant'Agostino and Sant'Egidio is also a must.

The famous Mille Miglia route offers a breathtakingly picturesque panorama, the enjoyment of which is enhanced by the pure pleasure of driving over an amazing succession of rolling hills and round never-ending curves!

At the wheel of his car, our Red Travel Tour Director guides you through this vivid land of enchanting towns and villages. The charm of southern Tuscany is encapsulated in the stunning Val d'Orcia, a picture-postcard valley, designated as a UNESCO World Heritage Site due to its colourful landscape, dotted with green cypress trees under an amazing blue sky. This truly unique experience offers a wealth of memories to treasure.

DAY 4: *Siena & Florence*

Route: Montalcino ▶ Siena ▶ Florence

Morning



Departure for Siena.

- Arrival in Siena and visit of this unspoiled mediaeval city, which is the location of the famous Palio, a horse race around the city's shell-shaped Piazza del Campo. Siena's other historic gems from the Middle Ages include the Town Hall (Palazzo Pubblico) and the Torre dei Mangia (1340), which are similar in height to the Cathedral.

- Free time to explore Siena.



Lunch in Siena - Restaurant suggestion: **Al Mangia**, located in Piazza del Campo, Siena's main square.

Afternoon



Next milestones of the famous Mille Miglia: Monteriggioni, Poggibonsi, San Casciano Val di Pesa, Florence, passing through the famous Chianti region vineyards.

Discovery of the picturesque and the breathtaking panorama offered by the valley landscape of the Chiantigiana Road, enriched by pure driving pleasure on an amazing succession of rolling hills and never-ending curves! En route: Castellina in Chianti, Radda in Chianti, Greve in Chianti.

- Arrival in Florence and check-in at **Four Seasons Hotel Firenze**.

An enchanted city sanctuary in the midst of Florence, where an art-filled Renaissance palazzo and conventino frame a centuries-old private park. Relax amidst original frescoes and sculptured relieves, graced by sunlight and airy garden vistas. Sip cappuccino under majestic trees, lounge by the open-air pool or bask in Italian spa secrets. Wonders of the Uffizi and Duomo are a stroll away. Tuscan hill towns beckon.
